Nature is our greatest arena. Year round (except this particular weekend, of course), trails, lighted tracks, and cycling paths invite you to run, hike or bike through the Illern Nature Reserve and endless Örsbäcken forests. For now, you can bring a bike and take

the opportunity to explore the brand new bike park next door to the arena or retreat to the nearby Stoeryd forests. Even better, stay an extra few days, and gather speed along our 7K mountain bike trail that winds through the reserve.

Beyond Bredstorp, Lake Sommen with its archipelago and crystal-clear water adds a special dimension to outdoor life. After the race, you may want to cool down with a refreshing swim, rent a kayak and explore the quiet paddling waters, or discover the lake aboard the classic steamship S/S Boxholm II. Come again this winter, and you'll see forests turned into skitracks and the lake transformed to a gigant skating rink – meaning Tranås invites you to outdoor adventures year round.

- It is not permitted for women to run the Men's course first and then the Women's course.
- It is not permitted to participate more than once on the same course.

- On legs 2 and 3, two runners may participate in parallel (doubling).

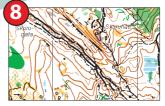

A trade-off – when it pays off to go around hilly and rough areas

-The ambition is to strike the right balance — sufficiently forked, yet offering proper challenges for the teams.

That's how Stefan Djurstedt, one of the three members of the coursesetting team for 10MILA 2026, puts it.

Stefan is joined in the team by Magnus Svensson and Jacob Lindstam. His own responsibility is the men's relay.

-I hope that the route choice legs will make an impact and give teams the opportunity to take their own initiatives. At the same time, I wish for a close relay, with several teams still in contention well into the race, he says.

Djurstedt is an experienced course setter. The 56-year-old, representing Eksjö SOK, has designed courses for both 10MILA and O-Ringen in the past.

-At 10MILA 2014 in Eksjö, I was responsible for the women's and youth relays. For O-Ringen 2009, I was in charge of one stage, he recalls.

Beyond that, he has numerous other course-setting assignments to his name — most recently the regional Götaland Championships in Eksjö earlier this year.

What can the runners expect from 10MILA 2026?

–In general, when studying the map, one might think there are too many paths, Stefan observes. At the same time, this is excellent terrain for night orienteering — both men and women will notice that.

Large parts of the competition area lie within Illern Nature Reserve, a well-visited recreation area designated for outdoor activities.

-There's great variation in the terrain. The western part is partly fast coniferous heath, mixed with rougher, more stony sections. You constantly have to assess whether a direct or around route choice will pay off best, he explains.

-There are also more featureless areas, which allow for longer legs. Lake Illern sits right in the middle of the map and influences the course design quite a bit.

This is the third year running with the same concept for 10MILA, after which a major evaluation will take place.

For the men's relay, the format means three evening and dusk legs before a break, followed by a restart with the long night — a straight leg of just over 15 km.

Then follow three shorter, middle-distance-style legs, with many controls in path-rich terrain.

-The legs might look easy on paper, Stefan says, but the steepness can make things tricky — both physically and technically.

The Småland Relay has been held in this terrain a few times before, most recently in 2010. As a result, the organisers have a good idea of the expected pace.

–I estimate an average speed of about 5:20 per kilometre across all ten legs of the men's relay, concludes Stefan Djurstedt.



1500 places available on hard flooring

During 10MILA, we offer a total of around 1,500 accommodation places on hard surfaces. This includes two newly built schools – Junkaremålsskolan (opened in 2024) and Granelundsskolan (opened in 2025) – as well as several sports halls and gymnasiums across the municipality.

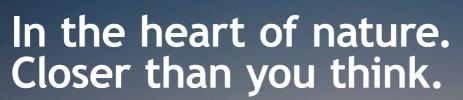
